3.4 We may disclose our personal information to third parties where:

- We have your consent;
- We use third parties to assist us in providing services and you have elected to receive one of those services. The third party would only be permitted to use your information for the purposes of providing that service to you; or
- We are compelled by law or a court order to do so, or if we believe that such action is necessary for the purpose of the legitimate interest pursued by IOCO, to protect and defend the rights, property or safety of IOCO, the site, visitors to the site or others.

4. Law enforcement authorities

We may, in our sole discretion, contact law enforcement authorities if we believe that anything unlawful is occurring in connection with the site. In this process, we may provide the law enforcement authorities with any personal information that is held by us.

5. Use of cookies
